The survey covered seminars, whether the membership fee was good value for money etc. There was agreement that the National Seminars continue as is i.e., one on-line and one in person. 81 members believed the membership was good value for money. There were some comments about the branch seminars and hopefully with the changes we are introducing this will address these comments.

National Seminars were held in March (on-line) and September (in person) and these were well attended with great topics being covered and thanks go to Lorraine for organizing and to the speakers who gave up their time to present to us.

Glasgow hosted this year's Dinner/Dance and AGM and it was a great night and enjoyed by everyone who attended. It was lovely to see so many members and their guests attend. Well done Glasgow for organizing a great night and thank you to the Glasgow Branch for their hard work in arranging this. Next year Aberdeen are hosting the Dinner/Dance and AGM and they are celebrating a big birthday so look out for the invite later on next year. I am sure it will be another great night and I look forward to seeing many of you there!

I want to thank all committee members whether they sit on General Council or on branch committees for their dedication to SOLAS and for all their hard work throughout the year, it is greatly appreciated. I would urge members to continue to support SOLAS whether it is by attending branch seminars, attending the dinner/dance/AGM or by sitting on branch committees or General Council because without your support SOLAS would not be able to continue.
